

Where will the class be held?

Once you enter the complex, follow the driveway to the right, leading you to Building C. You may park in any open parking spot. Building C is located in the rear; please know that the odd suite numbers are on the right. Follow the signs to the elevator on your right (around the corner). Take the elevator to the 2nd floor, and follow the signs for the Monica Lewis School of Etiquette-275. Enter the double glass doors to your left, and proceed through the hall. Our office is adjacent to the entry door. You should see suite 275 with our website www.MLSOE.com on the windows.
